The following is a good short note about the effect of the "Top Two Primary" (Prop. 14) law on "primary" elections:

CA Open Primary (Prop 14) and its implications. In the races for Congress and state offices, voters can cross over and vote for a candidate of another party. It is possible that the "top two" for the November election could come from the same party, which occurred in some races in 2012, 2014, 2016 & 2018. (Note-during a Presidential Primary Election and when Central Committee Members are on the ballot, voters can only vote for candidates from their own party in those particular races.)
